

**ORDER**

At the August 15, 2000 Classified Information Procedures Act (CIPA) § 6(a) hearing, counsel for the Government requested an additional two weeks to submit further proposed substitutions relating to the Defendant's First § 5 Notice. *See also* Government's Motion for Substitutions Pursuant to CIPA § 6(c)(1) and Incorporated Memorandum of Law filed August 14, 2000. I found that request for the two-week extension had merit.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Deadlines regarding the Government's proposed substitutions related to the Defendant's First CIPA § 5 Notice are extended to:  
August 28, 2000                      Government must propose all substitutions  
September 5, 2000                  Defendant may file a response to the proposed substitutions
2. The August 31, 2000 hearing on the proposed substitutions is vacated and a hearing on the proposed substitutions is rescheduled at 9:00 a.m., September 19, 2000.
