GOVERNMENT'S NOTICE OF MAXIMUM PENALTIES

The United States of America, by and through the United States Attorney for the District of Massachusetts, hereby files its Notice of Maximum Penalties, in connection with the change-of-plea hearing under Fed. R. Crim. P. 11 currently scheduled for October 4, 2002 at 9:00 a.m. The government states that the charges in the Indictment in this case carry the following maximum and mandatory minimum penalties:

Count I: **Attempted Use of Weapon of Mass Destruction**
18 U.S.C. §2332a(a)(1)

Life in prison
Life of supervised release (see 18 U.S.C.
§§3583(j), 2332b(g)(5)(B)(i))
\$250,000 fine
\$100 mandatory special assessment

Count II: **Attempted Homicide**
18 U.S.C. §2332(b)(1)

20 years in prison
Life of supervised release see 18 U.S.C.

\$250,000 fine
\$100 mandatory special assessment

**Count III: Placing Explosive Device on Aircraft
49 U.S.C. §46505(b)(3) and (c)**

20 years in prison
Life of supervised release (see 18 U.S.C.
§§3583(j), 2332b(g)(5)(B)(iii))
\$250,000 fine
\$100 mandatory special assessment

**Count IV: Attempted Murder
49 U.S.C. §§46506(1) and 1113**

20 years in prison
Life of supervised release (see 18 U.S.C.

\$250,000 fine
\$100 mandatory special assessment

\$250,000 fine
\$100 mandatory special assessment

**Count VIII: Using a Destructive Device During and In
Relation to a Crime of Violence
18 U.S.C. §924(c)**

Mandatory minimum of 30 years and a maximum
of life in prison that must be
consecutive to any other term of
imprisonment
5 years of supervised release
\$250,000 fine
\$100 mandatory special assessment

In addition to the foregoing penalties, Defendant Richard Colvin Reid is also subject to deportation or exclusion or both by the Immigration and Naturalization Service.
